SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- Medium: Open to all visual art mediums, including but not limited to painting, drawing, photography, and digital art.
- Deadline: Submissions must be received by March 15, 2024

SIGNATURE ART: The concept image must be adaptable, in whole or in part, for the use in other media, including but without limitation, advertisements, t-shirts, brochures and rack cards. Typography should not be included within the art.

Please include a brief artist statement with your submission, sharing your inspiration and connection to Kona's coffee culture.
